

TERMS OF REFERENCE

International Trustee, Advisor and Ambassador

TRUSTEE:

Religions for Peace (RfP) International Trustees (*Trustees***)** are a select group of eminent international leaders who offer annual financial contribution to *R/P* and provide critical liaison with a wide range of private and public entities to mobilize financial resources for *R/P*.

Trustees are invited to R/P World Council and other governance meetings and are provided with opportunities to participate in R/P's programs and projects. Trustees contribute at a wide range with the minimum of \$25,000 annually.

ADVISOR:

RfP International Advisors (*Advisors*) are internationally recognized scholars, experts and/or practitioners who make available special competencies relevant to the mission of *RfP*.

Advisors are invited to provide organizational policy and issue-based guidance to the Secretary General.

AMBASSADOR:

RfP International Goodwill Ambassadors (*Ambassadors*) are internationally known celebrities and personalities in diverse fields such as culture, entertainment, business or political, who liaison with important publics to raise the global profile of *R/P*.

Ambassadors serve as advocates and communicators with media to systematically raise RfP global profile.

CRITERIA:

- 1. Each must sign on to the values, vision, mission and principles of *RfP*.
- 2. Each has the abilities and competencies essential to the development of the mission of RfP.
- 3. Each group manifests the diversity inherent to the R/P mission (religious, gender, and geography).
