1. Background

Faith-based organizations (FBOs) and religious leaders play a crucial role in addressing climate change at the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) Conference of Parties. Their involvement demonstrates that religious and spiritual communities are integral to global efforts against climate change and are essential partners in achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and the objectives of the Paris Agreement.

The commitment to achieving the SDGs emphasizes the importance of cultivating inclusive societies and forming sustainable partnerships. Within this framework, the emphasis on SDG 16, which promotes peaceful and inclusive societies with access to justice, and SDG 17, which focuses on strengthening the means of implementation for sustainable development, is of paramount importance. Aligned with these goals, this side event aims to highlight the pivotal role of young women and youth in realizing the climate change agenda and fostering sustainable global partnerships from a faith perspective.

This side event aims to provide a platform for open discussion and collaboration, recognizing the role of youth in faith communities in achieving climate action goals outlined in SDGs 16 and 17. Through this discussion, we hope to foster inclusivity, efficiency, and sustainable partnerships for a more resilient and climate-conscious future.

2. Objectives of the side event, including relation with the SDGs identified in the Guidelines

Create awareness about the role of SDG 16 in promoting inclusive and peaceful societies
within the context of the climate change agenda and discuss the potential of youth in faith
communities as catalysts for positive change in achieving justice and inclusivity in climate
action.

- Provide a shared platform for reflection and knowledge exchange on the role of youth from faith communities in promoting inclusive approaches within the climate agenda, with faith as a catalyst for the realization of peaceful and just societies.
- Discuss and explore available resources and opportunities within youth serving faith organizations that can be used to catalyze meaningful inclusion of young boys and girls as partners, alongside other stakeholders, in the realization of SDG 17 within the climate agenda.
- Explore case studies and best practices where youth serving faith organizations have successfully mobilized youth in collaboration with other stakeholders to contribute to the implementation of sustainable development initiatives in the context of climate change.
